

## HOW TO FIND US

### From Aberaeron

Follow the A482 until you enter Ciliau Aeron. Opposite primary school turn left. Go along country road and turn first right. Hotel will be on right hand side.

### From Lampeter

Follow the A482 until you enter Ciliau Aeron. Opposite primary school turn right. Go along country road and turn first right. Hotel will be on right hand side.

- Aberystwyth 30 minutes
- Swansea 85 minutes
- Machynlleth 55 minutes
- Cardiff 120 minutes

The nearest major train stations can be found at Carmarthen and Aberystwyth, for train timetables you can contact National Rail enquiries or by phone on 08457 484950. The nearest bus stop can be found in Ciliau Aeron, which is 1 mile away. For bus timetables you can contact Ceredigion direct on 01267 234567.

Please be aware that the TyGlyn postcode is shared by a number of different properties in the immediate area. We would suggest that when using satellite navigation systems that you follow signs for TyGlyn restaurant with rooms as soon as you are in Ciliau Aeron.

Arriving by bike? Not a problem, bike's can be stored inside - prior notice is advisable.

## POINTS TO NOTE

### Arrivals and Departures
